He then served as CEO of a 600-member energy efficiency organization in Québec from 1999 to 2005.

Denis Tanguay received an honours BA in Economics from the University of Sherbrooke and a Masters degree in Economics from Carleton University. Over the years, he has written a number of strategic papers, and analytical documents for clients in the private and public sectors and was invited as guest speaker in many conferences in Canada and around the world. He made several appearances in public consultations, in parliamentary commissions and public utilities board hearings.

"My colleagues on the Board of EVO and I are extremely pleased to welcome Denis as our new Executive Director. In addition to his vast NGO experience, he combines the right skills and talent to not only bring fresh insights to our current activities but also to help us take EVO to the next level" said Thomas Dreessen.
